**Starting Annual Salary Range:** JSP 9-11, currently \$42,955.00 to \$51,972.00, depending upon qualifications and experience. This position falls within the Judicial Salary Plan of the United States Judiciary and is therefore outside the scope of Civil Service. Salary, retirement and other benefits compare to those for employees of Civil Service.

**Qualifications:** To qualify for the position the applicant must be a law school graduate as of March 1, 2006. Substantial research, writing or editorial experience is desired but not mandatory.

**General Job Description:** The law clerk will be required to do legal research, draft memoranda and opinions, counsel with the Judge and members of staff on legal matters affecting the administration of bankruptcy laws, and perform other duties as prescribed by the Judge and staff. A portion of the clerk's time will be spent in the courtroom observing proceedings and performing other courtroom duties. Travel to the other divisions located within the Southern District of Georgia may be necessary.

**INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS:** Employees of the United States Bankruptcy Court serve on an "AT WILL" basis and are required to adhere to a Code of Conduct.
