PUBLIC NOTICE

Procedural Change: Motions to Extend or Impose Stay

Effective Friday, February 15, 2008, the following procedural change will be implemented:

Upon the filing of a Motion to Extend/Impose Stay, the Clerk's Office will issue a negative notice which schedules the motion for hearing and sets a fifteen (15) day response deadline to consider timely objections. If no timely objection is filed, an order will be entered granting the relief requested and the matter will be removed from the Court's calender.

To qualify for negative notice processing, a motion to Extend/Impose Stay must provide sufficient detail; in particular, the motion must:

- 1) set forth specific facts to justify the relief requested and
- 2) be accompanied by a verification under oath by the debtor.

Otherwise, the motion will be scheduled for hearing and counsel required to appear.

Motions which do not allow adequate time for negative noticing will be scheduled for hearing.
