**PUBLIC NOTICE**

**AMENDMENTS TO PETITIONS, LISTS, SCHEDULES OR STATEMENTS**

When debtor files an amendment to the petition, lists, schedules or statements previously filed, Local Bankruptcy Rule 1009-1 requires the debtor to send to the United States Trustee, any trustee appointed, and any and all entities affected by the amendment, notice of said amendment.

If debtor adds creditors to a case by supplementing the schedules or list of creditors previously filed, the debtor shall serve upon each newly-listed creditor a copy of:

- 1) The amendment;
- 2) The meeting of creditors notice;
- 3) The Order Granting Discharge (if any); and
- 4) Any other document affecting the rights of said creditors.

When filed with the Court, amendments of the kind specified in LBR 1009-1 shall be accompanied by debtor's proof of service that the required notice was given.
