GENERAL ORDER NUMBER 2017-3 Order Adopting Local Chapter 13 Plan

After public notice and an opportunity for comment, the Court adopts a local Chapter 13 plan that conforms to the requirements of Fed. R. Bankr. P. 3015.1. The form plan is available on the Court's website at <u>www.gasb.uscourts.gov</u>, and it may be revised periodically. The debtor is required to use the form plan in: (1) all Chapter 13 cases filed on or after December 1, 2017, (2) all cases that are converted to Chapter 13 on or after December 1, 2017, and (3) all Chapter 13 cases filed before December 1, 2017, in which the debtor has not filed a plan prior to December 1, 2017.

No later than 14 days from the petition date or the date the case converts to Chapter 13, the debtor shall file a Chapter 13 plan using the form plan. In addition, the form plan must be used by the debtor to propose any pre-confirmation amendments to the plan.

Service of Plan and Pre-Confirmation Amendments

Pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 3015(d) and this General Order, the debtor shall serve the Chapter 13 plan and any amended plan on the Chapter 13 trustee and all creditors when the plan is filed with the Court, and the debtor shall file a certificate of service accordingly.

This General Order vacates General Order 2005-3. The following General Orders remain vacated: General Orders 1994-12, 1995-2, 1996-2, 1997-1, and 2001-1.
