**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2016-1**

**Inaccessibility of Clerk's Office During Hurricane Matthew**

Due to emergency conditions resulting from Hurricane Matthew in this district and the direct consequences thereof, the federal courthouses in Savannah and Brunswick, Georgia, and the offices of the Clerk of Court in those locations were closed on October 6 and 7, 2016. Additionally, the court experienced consistent technical difficulties with its electronic filing systems, starting at 6 p.m. (EDT) on October 5, 2016, and lasting for the remainder of the week, rendering the Clerk's office inaccessible throughout the district within the meaning of Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9006(a)(3). Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that because of the closing of the Savannah and Brunswick courthouses and the consistent technical failures throughout the district with the court's electronic filing systems, filing deadlines occurring on or after 6:00 p.m. (EDT) on October 5, 2016 through October 7, 2016, in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Georgia are extended in accordance with Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9006(a)(3).
