GENERAL ORDER 2005-8

Order Requiring Chapter 13 Plan Payment by Wage Withholding

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that when the Chapter 13 plan is filed, the Court will issue an order to the debtor's employer to withhold from the debtor's wages an amount equal to the proposed payments under the debtor's plan. If the debtor does not wish to be subjected to wage withholding, a motion must be submitted with the petition for direct pay to the Trustee setting forth why wage withholding would not be in the best interest of the debtor, the creditors or the Chapter 13 Trustee. Absent the filing of such a motion withholding will commence the first pay period following the filing of the plan and service of the Withholding Order on the debtor's employer. The debtor shall notify the Chapter 13 Trustee of any changes in employment and/or withholding subsequent to the filing of the plan whereby the Chapter 13 Trustee shall file an amended Withholding Order with the Court.

Every Chapter 13 plan must be accompanied by a complete Order to Commence Withholding (Local Form 2005-8-a) unless a motion for direct pay has been filed. Failure to file the aforementioned order or motion may cause the case to be dismissed.
